

ACMFF summer camp policy and guidelines a/o 6-2022

Alternate funding

Most summer camps provide financial help to qualifying children in need.

You must apply for this funding prior to submitting an ACMFF request.

An official denial letter from the camp, on camp letterhead, must be provided with the justification letter for a summer camp request to be considered by the ACMFF committee.

Additional sources of funding must be considered. All denial letters must be included in the request to substantiate a thorough effort at finding other sources of funding.

Requests that are submitted without documentation of attempts at alternate funding and their corresponding denial letters will not be shared with the ACMFF committee.

Justification letter

In addition to the normal requirements, ACMFF requests for summer camp must include the following in the justification letter:

- The type of camp
- Why the child would benefit from participating
- The frequency of attendance (times per week)
- Cost per day or week (whichever applies)
- Duration of the camp (half day, full day, overnight)

Proof-of cost should show all these points, as well.
