## Who is eligible?

To be eligible, a person must

- › be a resident of Allegheny County;
- › have applied for and be waiting to get medical assistance (MA) or third-party prescription cover-age; and
- › have an adjusted gross income of less than \$500 per year. (This calculation will be done at in-take).

**The Pharmacy Benefit Program is the payer-of-last-resort in all cases.**

## How to get free psychiatric prescription medication



**be eligible, see above.**



**call and make an in-take appointment at one of the Providers listed below.**



**go to the appointment with the necessary financial information.**



**be assigned a professional (therapist, psychologist, psychiatrist) to determine your diagnosis and the treatment plan that's right for you.**



**receive a prescription for your medication.**
