



Property Tax Credit for First Responders

Ordinance 03-24-OR, established a property tax credit for individuals who volunteer time with a volunteer fire department or non-profit EMS service provider in Allegheny County. The department of Emergency Services and the County Treasurer, who will ultimately administer the program, are in the process of finalizing eligibility standards and processes based upon number of hours volunteered, calls answered and other activities performed. Legislative Updates

Ordinance 01-24-OR established uniform training guidelines for members of the Board of Property Assessment Appeals and Review. [Allegheny County Council - File #: 12917-24 \(legistar.com\)](#) Ordinance 02-24-OR changed the process for issuing property tax appeal decisions. [Allegheny County Council - File #: 12918-24 \(legistar.com\)](#) These two ordinances together are intended to assure uniformity in results, and the final appeal verdict are issued more quickly.

Ordinance 05-24-OR amended Article 209 of the Administrative Code in order to ensure continuity in the Chief Assessment Officer position. [Allegheny County Council - File #: 12915-24 \(legistar.com\)](#)

Ordinance 06-24-OR moves the March 31, 2025 deadline for filing property tax appeals to October 1, 2024. In all years after 2024, the deadline will be September 1st. This change has no impact on appeals already filed for 2024. [Allegheny County Council - File #: 13056-24 \(legistar.com\)](#)

Ordinance 07-24-OR ratified significant changes to the Allegheny County Health Department's rules and regulations governing housing and community environment. These changes clarify safety standards to which property owners must adhere, tenant responsibilities with respect to maintenance and safety, lead hazard abatement, pest control and trash disposal. 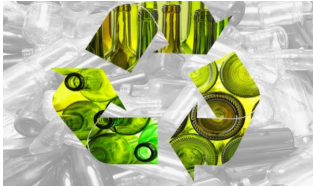

Traveling Glass Recycling Program

Allegheny County's Department of Sustainability and PRC has rolled out a Traveling Glass Recycling program. This self-serve glass drop-off site travels to various locations around the county, making it easier to recycle glass.



Why recycle glass?



Glass is still one of the most recyclable materials we generate in our homes and should not be trashed. Glass bottles and jars are 100% recyclable and can be recycled endlessly without losing any quality! This makes the effort to put these items back into the recycling ecosystem even more important.

How do I prepare the glass?

Containers should be empty and rinsed. Lids and labels don't need to be removed. Please remember that any bags and boxes used to carry the glass must be taken with you and discarded off-site.

What types of glass are acceptable?

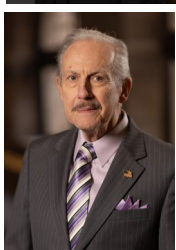
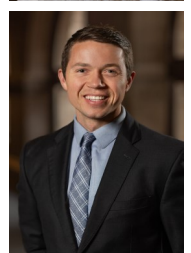

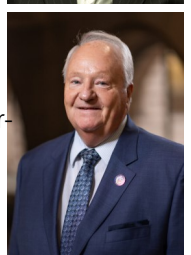
