Job Summary

Under the supervision of the Facility Manager, this position is responsible for a variety of duties encompassed in the day-to-day operation of a recreation facility. Duties will include instructing skiers and snowboarders of all ages and abilities how to improve their ski/board skills, while providing a fun and effective learning environment.

Explanatory Comments

The work activities of this position include instructing groups and /or individuals in a lesson format, teaching proper technique appropriate to the ability level of those being instructed and promotes safety and gives students the knowledge to remain safe when they leave lessons to ski/board on their own.

The Ski & Tubing Area operates mid-December until mid-March and requires employees to work evenings, weekends, and holidays.

Training and Experience Required

This position requires the ability to ski safely and confidently in all ski conditions and in varying types of terrain, along with strong public relations skills with an outgoing personality and ability and patience to teach skiers and snowboards.

Major Duties

- **Instruct** skiers and snowboards of all ability levels in an individual or group lesson.
- **Enforce** rules and regulations at facility to which assigned.
- **Perform** related duties as assigned by supervisor.

Wages

- \$15/hour
