

County Pool Rules and Regulations

1. The Allegheny County Department of Parks retains the right to refuse any individual's admission into its facilities.
2. Only the Facility Manager, Assistant Manager, Head Guard or other supervisory personnel have the right to eject anyone from the pool area or bathhouse who is conducting him/herself in such a manner as to jeopardize the safety of him/her or others.
3. Personal conduct in the pool and bathhouse should not jeopardize the safety of any pool patrons, including themselves.
4. Alcoholic beverages and/or controlled substances of any kind are strictly prohibited and should not be consumed in the facility.
5. Glass containers/bottles/cups are not permitted in the facility.
6. Only authorized personnel are allowed in the filtration area, cashier's booth, guard room or private sectors of the concession stand.
7. Only lifeguards are permitted in the guard chairs.
8. No profane, abusive or vulgar language shall be used; including music being played through personal speakers/radios.
9. Radios/Speakers should maintain a volume that does not interfere with any emergency signals, public address system, or disturb other patrons.
10. Rough, boisterous play, and/or running in the pool area (especially in shallow water) is not permitted at any time.
11. Spitting out/ spouting water in the pool or pool area is prohibited.
12. Lifejackets must have certification displayed and must be:
 - Coast Guard Approved – See chart below
 - In good & serviceable condition
 - The appropriate size for the intended user

13. The following items are prohibited in the pool and pool area:
 - Beach balls and other related toys (such as footballs, etc.)
 - Masks, fins and snorkels

14. Only shatterproof glasses (including sun glasses) with a tight-fitting safety strap can be worn inside the pool.
15. Organized group leaders assume the direct responsibility of the conduct and behavior of the members of their group while at the pool.
16. Infants and Children in diapers must wear a protective diaper cover or swimming diapers while in the pool.
17. Patrons showing signs of illness or disease, skin rash or sores are not permitted in or around the pool, unless a recent written authorization from a physician is provided to a pool manager..
18. It is at the discretion of the Pool Manager and/or Head Lifeguard if pool guests with any amount of body plaster, adhesive tape and/or bandages on their body will be permitted in the water.
19. **Only rafts rented from the pool facility are acceptable for use.**
20. Rented rafts are not permitted in the diving pool at Settlers Cabin Park.
21. Rafts should be returned in the same condition as when it was received. Additionally, raft users should NOT:
 - Kneel or stand on rafts when they are in the water.
 - Sit, lay, stand or jump on rafts when they are not being used in the water.
 - Jump in/on or dive through the center of their rafts from the side of the pool.
 - Drag their rafts along the ground.
22. Denim cut-offs are not an acceptable swimming attire.
23. **Outside food and/or coolers are not permitted in the facility.**
24. **Smoking is STRICTLY PROHIBITED inside the gated pool area.**
25. "Lost and Found" articles will be held for two weeks before disposal.
26. The Facility Management, Head Lifeguard or other supervisory personnel reserves the right to suspend anyone from the pool who is violating the rules and/or jeopardizing the safety and pleasure of other patrons.
27. Additional rules may be deemed advisable to meet certain conditions for any individual facility.
