II. Approval of Minutes of the January 3, 2018 meeting: Commissioner Price made a motion to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner McCurdy and carried unanimously.

III. Chairperson Update: Acting Chairperson Styche announced the resignation of Chairperson Stephan Broadus. Commissioner Price nominated Vice Chairperson Styche for the position of Chairperson. The motion was seconded by Commissioner McCurdy and carried unanimously.

Chairperson Styche resigned his position as Vice Chairperson and nominated Jessica McCurdy as Vice Chairperson. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Price and carried unanimously.

Law: Ms. Liebenguth reported no new cases have been received. Compliance Review Committee #1 met and addressed outstanding issues. Compliance Review Committee #2 has two issues to discuss. Committee meetings will take place via phone-conference.

Human Resources: Ms. Grabowski announced that the complaint intake questionnaires have been placed on the Commission's webpage. She also announced that she will ensure that the webpage is updated to reflect the recent nominations.

- V. Community Events: Commission Henry-Taylor announce that the Bar Association's African American Attorney's will be honoring a local non-profit group who championed equal rights on February 8, 2018.

Chairperson Styche will send a letter to the Allegheny Intermediate Unit reminding school districts about the Diversity Awards.

- VI. Announcements: Commissioner Price provided an update on the Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing Task Force. HUD has extended the deadline for recommendations for one year allowing additional time for public comment and input.
