## **POLICY**

It is the policy of the Allegheny County Bureau of Corrections to establish rules of accountability for County property issued to inmates.

## **PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES**

1. Inmates shall be responsible for all armbands, clothing and bedding issued to them during their detainment at the Allegheny County Jail.
2. An inmate may be charged for the damage of armbands, clothing, bedding, and any other County property.
3. The following is a list of charges for damaged items:

Damages not listed will require a list of costs for repairs from the Supply department.

4. When it is discovered that an inmate has damaged County property, an informal resolution form shall be completed. A copy will be given to the Cashier's department so that the inmate's account can be charged the cost of the damage(s). If no monies are present in the account, half of any future deposits will be seized until the debt is satisfied. Cost recovery for damaged property will be carried over into subsequent incarcerations until the debt is paid in full.
