**POLICY**

It is the policy of the Allegheny County Bureau of Corrections to establish a bed capacity for the facility.

The bed capacity of the Allegheny County Jail in year 2020 is: 3,183.

- The internal or “in-house” population may not exceed the jail’s approved bed capacity.
- The in-house population shall be calculated as the average daily inmate population for the six (6) calendar months prior to the date of the jail’s inspection.
- The 11X7 Shift Commander will forward a copy of the “Master Count Sheet” at the completion of their shift to the Administration.
- The Warden or his/her designee will review the count sheet to ensure the population has not exceeded the rated/approved bed capacity.
- When the inmate population is nearing capacity, the ACBOC will:
  - Work closely with the Administrator of Alternative Housing to identify inmates eligible for transfer to a program.
  - Work with the Courts to identify inmates eligible for Pre-Trial release.
