



North Park Blazed Trails - Southern Section




Trail Blaze Symbols

Because of the many trails in the park, dotted blazes have been used, besides the normal solid blaze (a red rectangle symbolized by a solid red line on the map for the North Ridge Trail). eg: A red blaze with a blue dot is symbolized by a solid red line with blue dashes. To clarify the blazes, a blaze symbol points to its corresponding blazed trail.
