If you have a bachelor's degree from Seton Hill, you qualify for a 5% tuition discount in most graduate programs.


Employer Reimbursement & Tuition Deferment

Some employers provide tuition reimbursement benefits. Check with your employer to see if you qualify. If you do, we can set you up with a tuition deferment plan that will give you more time to pay your bill. (Since you may not receive your reimbursement until after bills are due.)

Federal Loans

Graduate students are eligible for Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loans and Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loans. To apply, you must complete a FAFSA (see below), and a Master Promissory Note and Entrance Counseling Session at www.studentloans.gov.
