

## Free and Confidential HIV/STD Testing

The Allegheny County Health Department provides free and confidential HIV/STD testing. We are a free and confidential walk-in clinic. No appointment or insurance is necessary. Anyone 13 years and older can be seen at our clinic, regardless of immigration status. No parental consent is needed.

Our clinic routinely tests for HIV, chlamydia, gonorrhea, and syphilis. If a patient is diagnosed with chlamydia, gonorrhea, or syphilis, you will receive treatment onsite. If you are having symptoms additional testing may be offered. Patients diagnosed with HIV will receive referrals for medical care. We also provide Pre-exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) referrals.

We ask that patients bring photo ID (i.e. driver's license, passport, college ID) when being seen. If you do not have photo ID you will still be seen, but a photo ID is required to receive results.

## The Public Health Clinic Provides the Following Tests:

The STD Clinic provides testing for the following STDs and bacterial infections:

- HIV Testing (blood)
- Syphilis (blood)
- Chlamydia
- Gonorrhea
- Trichomoniasis (vaginal screening only)
- Yeast (vaginal screening only)
- Bacterial Vaginosis
- Non-gonococcal urethritis (NGU) (penile swab only)
- Hepatitis A, B, C (titers to check immunity):  
(Fee: \$25 Allegheny County residents and \$30 Non-Allegheny County residents)
- Scabies (treatment only)
- Pubic Lice (treatment only)
- Herpes (we do not provide a blood test, but will conduct a culture if lesions are present).



## The Public Health Clinic DOES NOT Provide Tests For the Following:

- Urinary Tract infection (UTI)
- Human Papilloma Virus (HPV)
- Pregnancy
- Physical Exams
- Rapid HIV tests

## Partner Services

Allegheny County Health Department staff can inform the sexual partners of patients with a positive STD diagnosis to come in for free confidential HIV/STD testing and treatment. This is a voluntary service for anyone diagnosed with a reportable STD. Staff members do not reveal the identity or any identifying information about the patient while informing partners. Partner notification works to reduce the spread of HIV/STDs in Allegheny County.
