**[PROPOSED] FIRST AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER**

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Parties shall complete discovery by the following deadlines, unless extended by the Hearing Officer for good cause by written motion:
  - a. All written discovery shall be served by November 20, 2020;
  - b. Fact depositions are permitted after the close of written fact discovery and shall be completed within 150 days after all COVID-19-related social-distancing restrictions are lifted such that the deposition(s) can be conducted with counsel, the witness(es), and any representative(s) present in-person;
  - c. Appellant’s expert report(s) shall be served within 60 days of completion of all fact depositions;
  - d. ACHD’s expert report(s) shall be served within 30 days of receipt of Appellant’s expert report(s);
  - e. Appellant’s rebuttal expert report(s) shall be served within 30 days of receipt of ACHD’s expert report(s); and
  - f. Any depositions of expert witnesses, as agreed to by the Parties, shall be completed within 60 days of exchanging all expert report(s), including Appellant’s rebuttal expert report(s).
  
2. Responses to written discovery are due no later than 30 days after service, unless extended pursuant to mutual agreement of the Parties or by the Hearing Officer for good cause by written motion.

3. Within 60 days of the exchange of all expert report(s), including Appellant's rebuttal expert report(s), the Parties shall advise the Hearing Officer of the status of the appeal and either: (1) propose a date for a hearing; or (2) advise the Hearing Officer that this matter is ripe for disposition without a hearing and propose a briefing schedule for such a disposition.
