Health Department's Immunization Clinic Relocates in Downtown Pittsburgh

PITTSBURGH – The Allegheny County Health Department (ACHD) announced today that its Immunization Clinic will be moving from its current location on Forbes Avenue in Oakland to the 4th floor of the Hartley-Rose building located in downtown Pittsburgh at 425 First Avenue. The new location is between Cherry Way and First Avenue, next to the Art Institute on the Boulevard of the Allies.

"We are excited to announce our new Immunization Clinic location," said Dr. Karen Hacker, Director of the Allegheny County Health Department. "Our new downtown location will provide an improved clinical site to best serve the citizens of Allegheny County and assure that everyone who needs vaccinations for travel or other, can get access."

The Immunization Clinic will be closed on January 17, 18 and 19 for the move. Phones will also be down during this time. Business will resume on Friday, January 20 at 9 a.m. in the new location.

The normal hours of operation for the Immunization Clinic will remain the same:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, 9a.m. – 4p.m.
Wednesday, 1p.m. – 8p.m.

The phone number to the clinic will also remain the same, 412- 578-8062.

The new location of the Clinic is conveniently located close to a number of bus lines including the 67 – Monroeville and 69 – Trafford. Information on bus lines and transit is available on the Port Authority of Allegheny County's website at www.portauthority.org or by calling 412-442-2000.

For those driving to the clinic, there are parking options in close proximity. The three closest to the new location are the Mon Wharf and the First and Second Avenue lots, in that order: <http://www.pittsburghparking.com/garages-and-attended-lots>. The STD-HIV/AIDS Clinic and Prevention Point Pittsburgh needle exchange will not be relocating. They will remain at 3441 Forbes Avenue in Oakland.
