Eight Food Establishments Opened in County in December

PITTSBURGH – The Allegheny County Health Department today reported that eight new food establishments opened in the County in December. There were five restaurants, a mobile vendor and two retailers.

“The Health Department’s monthly report highlights the new restaurants that use trans-fat free cooking oils. One of the five eateries that opened in the last month cooks with these healthier oils,” said Health Director Dr. Karen Hacker.

The establishment using trans-fat free cooking oil is Sesame Garden, 202 Shiloh Street, in the Mt. Washington neighborhood of the City of Pittsburgh.

Other new restaurants include The Staghorn Home & Garden Café, 517 Greenfield Avenue, in the Greenfield neighborhood of the City of Pittsburgh; The Slippery Mermaid Sushi Bar, 613 Beaver Street, Sewickley; Come ‘N Get It Café, 600 North Bell Avenue, Carnegie; and Dunkin’ Donuts, 1541 Washington Road, Mt. Lebanon.

Three additional food establishments opened last month: Palms Brazilian Steakhouse, 3113 Green Garden Road, Aliquippa (mobile vendor which will be operating in Allegheny County); Red Bull Salad Dressing, 525 West Main Street, Carnegie; and Dollar General, 5724 Smithfield Street, downtown in the City of Pittsburgh.
