Fitzgerald, Hacker Cut Ribbon on New Immunization Clinic Site

PITTSBURGH – County Executive Rich Fitzgerald and Health Department Director Dr. Karen Hacker today participated in a ribbon-cutting ceremony to celebrate the new location of the county’s Immunization Clinic. This past week, the clinic moved from Oakland to its new site on the 4th floor of the Hartley-Rose building located in downtown Pittsburgh at 425 First Avenue. The new location is between Cherry Way and First Avenue.

“I’m thrilled to celebrate this new location that will serve our residents and provide improved facilities for our staff and the individuals they serve,” said Fitzgerald. “Having a centrally-located facility is even more important during this flu season and allows us an opportunity to remind those who have not yet been vaccinated to do so now. Flu season most often peaks between December and March, so it’s not too late.”

The new location offers four brand new private exam rooms and an on-site, private lactation room to accommodate breastfeeding needs for both clients and staff. The new site also has more space and allowed the Health Department to provide new equipment for office staff.

“We are excited to announce our new Immunization Clinic location,” said Dr. Hacker. “Our new downtown location will provide an improved clinical site to best serve the citizens of Allegheny County and assure that everyone who needs vaccinations for travel or other, can get access.”

The Immunization Clinic offers adult immunization services, childhood immunizations, WIC certification and re-certification tests, travel immunizations and screening tests. Its hours of operation, as well as its phone number, will remain the same.
