Six New Food Establishments Open in Allegheny County in January

PITTSBURGH – The Allegheny County Health Department today reported that six new food establishments opened in the county in January including four restaurants, one food market and a child care center kitchen.

“The key to a healthy diet is choosing foods that have more good fats, than bad fats, or trans fats,” said Health Department Director Dr. Karen A. Hacker. “As part of our commitment to promoting individual and community wellness, we also look at and highlight those facilities that use trans-fat free cooking oils. We see more and more restaurants taking that step. This past month, three of the four eateries that opened cook with these healthier oils.”

Those establishments using trans-fat free cooking oils are Wingstop, 1324 East Carson Street, Pittsburgh (South Side neighborhood); Tootsie’s Diner, 701 Fifth Avenue, Coraopolis; and Spoonwood Brewing Company, 5981 Baptist Road, Bethel Park.

The other new restaurant is Circolo Woodfired, 2100 East Carson Street, Pittsburgh (South Side neighborhood).

Two other food establishments also opened last month: Hanini Market, 2625 Brownsville Road, Pittsburgh (Carrick neighborhood) and Sunshine Kids, Inc. – Room To Grow, 626 Cochran’s Mill Road, South Park.
