### **Six New Food Establishments Open in Allegheny County in February**

**PITTSBURGH** – The Allegheny County Health Department today reported that six new food establishments opened in the county in February including four restaurants, one bakery and a children’s indoor amusement center café.

“The key to a healthy diet is choosing foods that have more good fats than bad fats, or trans fats,” said Health Department Director, Dr. Karen A. Hacker. “As part of our county-wide commitment to promoting individual and community wellness, we also look at and highlight those facilities that use trans fat-free cooking oils. We see more restaurants taking that step toward living well. This past month, three of the four eateries that opened cook with these healthier oils.”

Those establishments using trans fat-free cooking oils are Namaste India II, 1400 Radford Road, Whitehall; Sola Pizza, 1417 East Carson Street and 20<sup>th</sup> Street Bar And Grill, 2019 East Carson Street, Pittsburgh (South Side neighborhood).

The other new restaurant is Jet’s Pizza, 1810 Dormont Avenue, Dormont.

Two other food establishments also opened last month: Cupcakes Most Wanted, 2312 Main Street, Sharpsburg and Playdate 4 Kids Café, 2898 Banksville Road, Pittsburgh (Banksville neighborhood).
