## **Health Department Announces New *Live Well Restaurants*, Food Establishments**

**PITTSBURGH** – The Allegheny County Health Department (ACHD) today announced that five eating establishments have met the qualifications for, and earned the designation as, *Live Well Restaurants*. Additionally, ten food establishments opened in the county in February, including six restaurants, one confectionary, a caterer, one food market, and a mobile vendor.

The new *Live Well Restaurants* are:

- Dinette, Pittsburgh (East Liberty)
- UPMC Shadyside Hospital Restaurant, Pittsburgh (Shadyside)
- Food & Nutrition Department at UPMC Presbyterian, Pittsburgh (Oakland)
- St. Clair Country Club, Upper St. Clair
- The Church Brew Works, Pittsburgh (Lawrenceville)

Each of the establishments has indicated the intent to work with the county to accomplish the goals of the campaign. Additionally, each has outlined steps to be taken by the facility to help meet those goals. At a minimum, the leadership at each establishment has committed to eliminating trans-fat oils, being smoke free and not selling tobacco products. Each has also committed to four additional action steps that are responsible business practices, and will provide healthy options for patrons.

“We are very excited by the new additions to the *Live Well Campaign*. *Live Well Restaurants* make healthy options available which is another step in making healthy choices” said Dr. Karen Hacker, Director of the Allegheny County Health Department. “In addition, we also look at and highlight those facilities that use trans fat-free cooking oils. Last month, five of the ten food establishments that opened cook with these healthier oils.”

Of the ten food establishments opened in February, five are using trans fat-free cooking oils:

- Buford’s Kitchen, 5980 University Boulevard, Moon
- Roost At Hilton Garden Inn, 250 Forbes Avenue, Pittsburgh (Downtown)
- Spork, 5430 Penn Avenue, Pittsburgh (Bloomfield)
- Mitch’s Mobile Barbeque Pit, 16070 Perry Highway, Marshall
- Who Made That?, 2312 Main Street, Sharpsburg
