### **Fifteen New Food Establishments Opened in March**

**PITTSBURGH** – The Allegheny County Health Department today reported that 15 new food establishments opened in the County in March. There were eight restaurants, two convenience stores, a bakery, one grocery store, two confectionaries, and a caterer.

“The Health Department’s monthly report highlights the new restaurants that use trans-fat free cooking oils. Two of the eight eateries that opened last month cook with these healthier oils,” said Health Director Dr. Karen Hacker.

The restaurants using trans-fat free cooking oils are One Thirty-One East, 131 East Main Street, Carnegie and San Lorenzo, 4407 Butler Street, Lawrenceville.

Other new restaurants include Island Spice, 160 Brownsville Road, Mt. Oliver; Patron’s Pizza, 1006 Washington Avenue, Carnegie; Cerasoli Pizzeria, 3053 Brighton Road, North Side; Hitchhiker Brewing Company, 190 Castle Shannon Boulevard, Mt. Lebanon; Thai Tamarind, 172 Lincoln Avenue, Squirrel Hill; and 1905 Eatery, 733 Broadway Avenue, McKees Rocks.
