New *Live Well Allegheny Restaurant*, Food Establishments Announced for April

PITTSBURGH – The Allegheny County Health Department (ACHD) today announced the latest restaurant to meet the qualifications and receive the *Live Well Allegheny Restaurant* designation. Additionally, eleven food establishments opened in the county in April, including six restaurants, three confectionaries, one bakery and a coffee/tea house.

The new *Live Well Allegheny Restaurant* is Café Phipps of Phipps Conservatory and Botanical Gardens located at One Schenley Park, Pittsburgh (Oakland neighborhood).

Café Phipps has committed to work with the county to accomplish the goals of the campaign by implementing practices to support healthy lifestyles. The café already has a number of offerings that it will continue that are healthy - including continuing to use the MyPlate model to create meals; offering organic, local and sustainable foods; prohibiting the sale of soda or junk food; using no artificial ingredients, trans fats or high fructose corn syrup; and, providing a children's menu featuring whole grains, organic fruits and vegetables, and ingredients that are minimally processed, low fat and low salt with no or little added sugar.

“We are very excited by the new addition to *Live Well Allegheny Restaurants*. These facilities make healthy options available which is another step in making healthy choices,” said Dr. Karen Hacker, Director of the Allegheny County Health Department. “In addition, we also look at and highlight those facilities that use trans fat-free cooking oils. Last month, eight of the seventeen new food establishments that opened cook with these healthier oils.”

Those facilities using trans fat-free cooking oils are:
