Thirteen New Food Establishments Opened in May

PITTSBURGH – The Allegheny County Health Department today reported that thirteen new food establishments opened in the County in May. There were nine restaurants, two confectionaries, one grocery store and a caterer.

“The Health Department’s monthly report highlights the new restaurants that use trans-fat free cooking oils. Three of the nine eateries that opened last month cook with these healthier oils,” said Health Director Dr. Karen Hacker.

The establishments using trans-fat free cooking oils are Sukhothai Bistro, 5813 Forbes Avenue, Squirrel Hill; Sawasdee Thai Kitchen, 112 Abbeyville Road, Mt. Lebanon; and Uncle Tony’s Pizza, 3285 West Liberty Avenue, Dormont.

Other new restaurants include Feng Japanese, 4305 Main Street, Bloomfield; Grist House Brewing, 10 Sherman Street, Millvale; Grand China Buffet & Grill, 1025 Washington Pike, N11, Collier; Altius, 1230 Grandview Avenue, Mt. Washington; Row House Cinema & Atlas Bottle Works, 4115 Butler Street, Lawrenceville; and Wendy’s, 7317 McKnight Road, Ross.

Three additional food establishments opened last month: Scoops In Bloomfield, 4806 Liberty Avenue, and Bottom Dollar Food, 5200 Penn Avenue, both in Bloomfield and Ola Appetit Catering Company, 900 Mehaffey Street, Duquesne.
