New *Live Well Allegheny Restaurants*, Food Establishments Announced for May

PITTSBURGH – The Allegheny County Health Department (ACHD) today announced that Franktuary is the latest restaurant to meet the qualifications and receive the *Live Well Allegheny Restaurant* designation. Additionally, twelve food establishments opened in the county in May, including seven restaurants, one café, two bakeries and two mobile vendors.

Both of Franktuary's locations, Lawrenceville at 3810 Butler Street and Market Square at 115 Forbes Avenue, are now part of the *Live Well Allegheny Restaurants* program. Specifically, Franktuary has committed to work with the county to accomplish the goals of the campaign by implementing practices to support healthy lifestyles. They have already committed to a number of actions that will provide healthier options such as providing salad or apple slices as alternatives to french fries, not using processed items containing high fructose corn syrup, and cultivating an on-site garden where vegetables and herbs are grown. The garden, among other environmentally conscious features, has earned them gold (Lawrenceville) and silver (Market Square) certification from Sustainable Pittsburgh Restaurants. "The key to a healthy diet is choosing foods that have more good fats than bad fats or trans fats," said Health Department Director, Dr. Karen Hacker. "As part of our county-wide commitment to promoting individual and community wellness, we also look at and highlight those facilities that use trans fat free cooking oils. We are seeing more eateries taking that step to provide healthier options toward living well."
