Ten New Food Establishments Opened in June

PITTSBURGH – The Allegheny County Health Department today reported that ten new food establishments opened in the County in June. There were eight restaurants, one coffee shop and a mobile vendor.

“The Health Department’s monthly report highlights the new restaurants that use trans-fat free cooking oils. Four of the eight eateries that opened last month cook with these healthier oils,” said Health Director Dr. Karen Hacker.

The establishments using trans-fat free cooking oils are Olive Oil’s Pizza & More, 4966 Library Road and Fairway Grille At Cool Springs, 1530 Hamilton Road, both in Bethel Park; Nick’s Pizza, 329 Mt. Lebanon Boulevard, Castle Shannon; and Jade Grille, 670 Washington Road, Mt. Lebanon.

Other new restaurants include Pink Box Bakery Café, 2104 Murray Avenue and Mandy’s Pizza, 1900 Murray Avenue, both in Squirrel Hill; Subba Asian Restaurant, 700 Cedar Avenue, 2nd Floor, Northside; and Jabroni’s Café, 5812 Library Road, Bethel Park.

Two additional food establishments opened last month: Fat Boys House Of BBQ, 192 Shiloh Avenue, Northside and Nikos Coffee, 1125 Penn Avenue, Downtown.
