Free Workshop on How to Become Preferred Vendor in Diesel Retrofit Program
Grant Recipients Strongly Encouraged to Deal with Preferred Vendors for Retrofits

PITTSBURGH – Manufacturers and vendors of diesel retrofits and other clean diesel technologies are invited to attend a free workshop Wednesday, August 6, to learn how they can join the preferred vendors list for Build It *with* Clean Diesel, a program designed to cut diesel emissions and improve air quality.

The program provides grants to help small construction companies with the cost of retrofitting, repowering or rebuilding diesel-powered equipment, which not only improves air quality and protects public health but can also extend the lifespan and increase the efficiency of such equipment.

Build It *with* Clean Diesel is funded by the Allegheny County Health Department and managed by the Mid-Atlantic Regional Air Management Association (MARAMA). The grants pay for 75% of the cost of engine repowers and 100% for retrofits, with up to \$100,000 available per company.

The workshop will be held from 9:30 to 10:30 a.m. at the Constructors Association of Western Pennsylvania (CAWP), 1201 Banksville Road, Pittsburgh. Registration is required in advance. Please contact Debbie Thomas at dthomas@marama.org or 443-322-0320.
