Nine New Food Establishments Opened in August

PITTSBURGH – The Allegheny County Health Department today reported that nine new food establishments opened in the County in August. There were six restaurants, a day care facility, one social hall, and a food market.

“The Health Department’s monthly report highlights the new restaurants that use trans-fat free cooking oils. Two of the six eateries that opened last month cook with these healthier oils,” said Health Director Dr. Karen Hacker.

The establishments using trans-fat free cooking oils are Matt’s Sub Shack & Pizza, 713 Little Deer Creek Valley Road, West Deer and Dorothy 6 Blast Furnace Café, 224 East 8th Avenue, Homestead.

Other new restaurants include Patsy’s Place, 5812 Library Road, Bethel Park; Simple Ingredients, 807 Liberty Avenue, Downtown; Bartram House Bakery Café, 2612 East Carson Street, Southside; and Café On The Corner, 2700 Shadeland Avenue, Marshall-Shadeland.

Three additional food establishments opened last month: American Hungarian Social Association, 936 East 8th Avenue, Munhall; Xpress Mart And Deli, 105 Seminary Avenue, Oakdale; and Little Bumblebee’s Daycare, 1705 Maple Street, Homestead.
