## **Newest *Live Well Allegheny* Restaurant and Food Establishments Announced**

**PITTSBURGH** – The Health Department (ACHD) announced that the Hogan Dining Center (Parkhurst Dining) on Duquesne University's campus is the latest restaurant to receive the *Live Well Allegheny Restaurant* designation. ACHD also announced that it issued licenses to 17 new food establishments in the county in October, which includes ten restaurants, a convenience and produce store, one supermarket, a specialty grocery store, one bakery, a coffee house and two confectionaries.

"We are very excited to welcome the Hogan Dining Center to our *Live Well Allegheny* family, and we appreciate their efforts to provide healthier food selections for students and faculty," said Dr. Karen Hacker, Health Department Director. "We are also excited to announce that eight new food establishments that were licensed in October are using trans-fat-free cooking oils, which is tied for the most in a single month in 2017. It's very encouraging to see these new establishments providing the healthiest food options for its customers, and for taking that step towards living well."
