Health Department Announces 21 New Food Establishments in November

PITTSBURGH – The Allegheny County Health Department (ACHD) is announcing the opening of 21 food establishments in the County over the last month, including sixteen restaurants, a confectionary, one kitchen share, a wine bar, and two bakeries.

“The key to a healthy diet is choosing foods that have more good fats than bad fats, or trans fats,” said Health Department Director, Dr. Karen Hacker. “As part of our county-wide commitment to promoting individual and community wellness, we also look at and highlight those facilities that use trans fat-free cooking oils. We see more restaurants taking that step toward living well. This past month, seven of the sixteen eateries that opened cook with these healthier oils.”

Those facilities using trans fat-free cooking oils are Ordinary Joe’s, 225 Commercial Avenue, Aspinwall; China Café, 5239 Brownsville Road, Baldwin Borough; Feeney’s Weenies, 2102 Broadway Avenue, Pittsburgh (Beechview neighborhood); The Goldmark, 4517 Butler Street, Pittsburgh (Lawrenceville neighborhood); Uncle Redd’s BBQ Ribs & Chicken, 6535 Saltsburg Road, Penn Hills; Walid’s Hook, Fish & Chicken #2, 1303 Brownsville Road, Mt. Oliver; and Insurrection Ale Works, 1635 East Railroad Street, Heidelberg.

The other new restaurants are The Fireside Public House, 6290 Broad Street, Pittsburgh (East Liberty neighborhood); Pizza Fiesta, 4911 Penn Avenue, Pittsburgh (Garfield neighborhood); Ches’ Anthony’s Performance Café, 1530 Hamilton Road, Bethel Park; Uptown Diner, 4779 William Flynn Highway, Hampton; HANA, 4407 Butler Street, Pittsburgh (Lawrenceville neighborhood); Industry Public House, 140 Andrew Drive, Robinson; Leaf & Plate, 5884 Ellsworth Avenue, Pittsburgh (Shadyside neighborhood); Big Shot Bob’s, 1006 Washington Avenue, Carnegie; and Mamma Mia Pizzeria, 511 East Carson Street, Pittsburgh (South Side neighborhood).

Five other food establishments also opened in November: The Butterwood Bake Consortium, 5222 Butler Street, Pittsburgh (Lawrenceville neighborhood); My Sweet Lilly, 2013 Penn Avenue, Pittsburgh (Downtown neighborhood); Love Yogurt, 229 Atwood Street, Pittsburgh (Oakland neighborhood); La Dorita/Barb’s Bars, 2312 Main Street, Sharpsburg; and Vino Volo, Pittsburgh International Airport, Terminal B, Findlay.
