

HABITAT FOR HEROES

Habitat for Humanity of Greater Pittsburgh is here to help our local veterans in Allegheny County.

The Veteran Housing Initiative is targeted to help our veterans with the following needs through our "A Brush With Kindness" program:

- Wheelchair ramps
- Accessibility modifications
- Minor roof repair
- Painting, siding, gutters, landscaping
- Window and door replacement
- Energy-saving weatherization

PROGRAM QUALIFICATIONS

If a veteran or their family is looking for assistance through our programs, they must meet the following guidelines:

- Must own and occupy a home in Allegheny County
- Meet income guidelines set by HFHGP
- Willing to partner with HFHGP including media coverage
- Able to afford necessary home repairs with nominal monthly payments
